October quotes:

"We love what happened this summer with the youth and hope to see it continue throughout the winter. Do you have an indoor location picked out for the LOT?" This ringing endorsement came from the **Youth Violence Prevention Council**, which has 2 dozen major regional leaders.

"Reaching this whole area is not a 'Bethel thing,' it's an 'all of us thing,'" Chris Overstreet, outreach pastor at **Bethel**, stated. *"We have done a lot to touch the city, but the relational aspect you carry is so crucial - let's partner more! I have a lot of ideas, but I don't want to do them without you."*

The campus pastor at **Simpson University**, gave me this heads-up in mid-October, *"We are about to hire a community coordinator whose main job is to get our students off 2211 College View Drive and into the city."* Dr. Rich Brown, Simpson VP, told me, *"Their first task will be to connect with Redding Transformation."*

We have been also been contacted in recent days by key people from **Risen King** as well as the women's ministry at **Neighborhood Church**. **Redding Christian School** joined us for a stellar community service day on Oct 16th. This unique Grace in Motion job was referred to us by a caring State Farm agent who saw a local widow's need. Before any work was done at her house, I was able to pray with her and share assurance of salvation in Jesus just during my initial assessment visit.

LIGHTS OF LIBERTY: Oct 18

The WER1 band was invited to sing at the community fireworks event again this year. Over 1000 were on hand and another thousand arrived as we sang about Christ and shared hope. Pleasantly surprised to see a Christian presence at a city event, many sang along and worshiped with us. We were given close to 60 minutes; other bands had less than 20 min. on stage. At the end of the event, I wanted to ask if they'd consider having us back next year in a later time slot with more crowd present, but wasn't sure how they'd respond since we had been quite "Jesus" and "Bible" heavy. So I said, *"You know, next year it would be nice to play in a later spot, what say you?"* Without hesitating, the organizer said, *"SURE! You got it."*
