GETTING INVOLVED STEP BY STEP

1. Fill out an application form

2. Participate in screening, interview & initial training
3. Commit to at least an hour a week for one year.
4. Have an initial meeting with mentee.
5. Spend time together weekly (Destination Points are available by local supporting businesses.)
6. Attend trainings for reporting, support and enrichment.
7. Watch on-line training videos (available 24/7).
